Dear Parents,

The state of Mississippi is requesting authorization from the federal government to approve another round of P-EBT benefits for the 2021-2022 school year. Although the request has not been approved, we want to be proactive in making sure that all eligible students receive their benefits.

- **To be eligible to receive these benefits, children must qualify for free or reduced priced meals under the National School Lunch Program.**
- **To prevent delays in receiving any new P-EBT benefits, please make sure that you have submitted a Free & Reduced meal application by April 29, 2022.**
- **If you have already completed a meal application form for SY 2021-22 there is no need to submit another one.**
- **You should also make sure that your mailing address is correct. If not, please contact your child's school to update that information.**

If you have not submitted a meal application for the 2021-22 school year, please do so. You can request a hardcopy form from your student's school or go online to [myschoolapps.com](https://myschoolapps.com) to complete an electronic application.
