The weather forecast currently predicts the possibility of inclement wintry weather across Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of next week, February 17th, 18th, and 19th. With that in mind, we are sending this distance learning packet and/or instructions home with your child to be worked in the event of a school closure. The materials are clearly marked as to what should be completed and when. If you have access to Wi-Fi, your child will also log onto Google Classroom for updates and announcements from the teacher.
